

3. State Government will be responsible for allocation and monitoring of resources for SC/ST/ Women beneficiaries and maintain database for the same as per extant Guidelines of the scheme.

4. The Administrative Approval is tentative and subject to variation/ adjustment as Government of India may decide for implementation of the scheme during current financial year. Implementing agencies must ensure compliance of various

guidelines/instructions relating to implementation of the scheme, as also financial rules & procedures, as may be applicable.
